A grant of just £400 helped fund a week's summer holiday for these children from a deprived area of Kettering. For many of these youngsters it was their first holiday away from home.



A £2,000 grant has enabled these women from the Dostiyo group in Northampton to enjoy a weekly social and healthy living club—complete with aerobics, yoga and group discussions.



Young parents from low income families in Kettering's Highfield and Croyland enjoy cookery lessons, weight management and motivation sessions—thanks to a £4,700 grant from the Foundation.

More than 60 blind and partially sighted elderly people from Good Companions in Northampton socialise and dance together every month at Wardington Court thanks to a grant of £1,000 from the Foundation.
