# Summary

Northamptonshire has areas that are in the **top 1 per cent most deprived nationally** for education and skills, income and employment, health, crime and housing.

On exploring the **adult health and wellbeing** in **Corby** and **Northampton**, issues identified included:





**Life expectancy for males and females** was lower in **Corby** and **Northampton**, with **Daventry** reporting also reporting lower female life expectancy.






# Population and Deprivation

## Population and Growth

4.5%

4.5% increase in population, which exceeds national and regional growth trends



The highest proportions of older people are concentrated in **Daventry**, **East Northamptonshire**, **South Northamptonshire** and **Wellingborough**.

65+

Those aged 65 years and over now account for 17.3% of the population.

The highest proportion of non-white British communities is the **Asian community** (3.67%)

Followed by the **Black Caribbean community** (estimated at 2.45%)

## Child poverty

**Childhood poverty leads to negative health outcomes and premature mortality.**

**21,730**

The proportion of children and young people **under 16 years-old living in low incomes families** was 15 per cent in Northamptonshire, lower than the national average (20.1 per cent).








# Health and Wellbeing


Adults hospitalised for self-harm related injuries

**Life expectancy in Corby is significantly lower** for both men (76.7) and women (79.5), than the national average (79.5 and 83.2, respectively).

## Housing



The number of homeless people per 1,000 households in **Corby (3.07)** and **Northampton (3.44)** were considerably higher than the national average (2.52).

## Crime




# Population: 66,854 (Up 9.1% from 2011)

## Daventry

**Population: 80,014 (Up 2.8% from 2011)**



Significantly higher levels of self-harm than the national average



Below national average life expectancy for females



Higher proportion of elderly male and female residents aged 65-74 than across the country





## East Northamptonshire

**Population: 89,746 (Up 3.4% from 2011)**



More children have Special Educational Needs (SEN) than the national average (13.38% compared to 11.6%)

6.5% of those aged 16-24 are not in Education, Employment or Training (NEET)

32.4% of adults in the most deprived areas have no qualifications






## Kettering

**Population: 97,650 (Up 4.5% from 2011)**

**High levels of alcohol and self-harm related hospitalisation**

Increased number of deaths from smoking (278 per 100,000 of population, compared to 274 nationally)




Higher crime rate than national average (39.9 crimes per 1,000 people), shoplifting nearly three times the national average





# Northampton

**Population: 222,462 (Up 4.9% from 2011)**



8,400 (19.1%) of children live in low income families – 15.3% of children live in out of work households



Ranked in the top 20% in the UK for barriers to housing

In top 20% of most deprived areas in the UK for education, skills and training





## South Northamptonshire


**Population: 89,116 (Up 4.6% from 2011)**



Higher than average elderly population – 28.65% of males and 29.21% of females are aged 65-74



More under 18s hospitalised for alcohol related issues than the national average

## Wellingborough


# Population: 77,184 (Up 2.4% from 2011)



Second highest rate for NEET young people in the county (7.2%)



In top 20% of most deprived areas in the UK for Health and Disability and Employment



2,900 (18.9%) of children live in low income families – 14.2% of 10-15 year-olds live in out-of-work households, higher than the national average



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
