We will promote philanthropy and generosity to those who want to give back to their communities, through the giving of both time and financial support to help increase a community asset for future generations which we aim to build to £28 million by 2028.

We will build on existing relationships and provide all round excellent stewardship to our donors.

We will actively focus on next generation philanthropists to enable them to be part of the conversation in building thriving communities.

Legacy giving will be a key part of the long-term sustainable goal for the Foundation, and we will build on examples from recent successful legacy gifts and intentions to give.

We will explore new ways to engage with a diverse range of donors and utilise digital technology to connect with and reach philanthropists and generosity givers across Northamptonshire.

How will we do this?

Encourage Giving

Create resources and engage with a range of people in our community about different ways they can give back, whether it's through volunteering their time, donating money, or leaving a legacy for future generations. By showing them how their generosity can make a real difference, we hope to inspire more people to support our cause.

Thank Our Supporters

We believe in showing our appreciation to the amazing people who support us. We'll keep in touch with our donors regularly, updating them on how their contributions are making a difference. We'll involve them in decisions and make sure they know just how much we value their support.

Inspire the Next Generation

We're passionate about getting young people involved in giving back to their community. We'll create special programmes and events just for them through Young Philanthropy, giving them opportunities to learn, connect, and make a difference. By empowering them to be philanthropists, we're investing in a brighter future for our community.

Leave a Lasting Legacy

We'll talk about the importance of leaving a legacy for future generations and showcase how it's made a big impact in our community. We will provide resources and support to include us in their estate planning, ensuring that their generosity lives on for years to come.

Go Digital

We're embracing technology to make it easier for everyone to get involved. We'll be active on social media, have a user-friendly website, and use data to tailor our messages to potential donors. We'll also explore virtual events and digital fundraising platforms to reach even more people who want to support our cause. GOAL TWO: INCREASE IMPACT ACROSS OUR GIVING

We measure the impact of our grant making and philanthropy to help show the difference made by investing in voluntary community groups and local charities and their work to build better communities. In doing so we help build a picture of the value of place-based funding to nurture and grow local civil society. We also know that to increase the impact of our giving means to grow the number of funds we provide, increase the impact of our investments, and ensure we reach into all communities.

We will increase our impact across our giving by working to grow the funds we can give out now and, in the future, and aim to award £2 million in grant making annually.

We will continue to be an impact champion and implement from 2024 an updated impact framework to better measure the difference made by the grant awards made on behalf of our donors.

We will start to communicate our grant making and giving in relation to its philanthropic contribution to meeting the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals including working towards better impact investment.

We will continue to utilise local intelligence, reports and track local need and adopt new grant making processes and programme design to ensure that our grant making is timely and responsive to emerging need as well as strategically addressing longer term priorities and needs within local communities. We will through ongoing equity, diversity and inclusion principles ensure that our grant making reaches into all across Northamptonshire thereby enhancing the impact of our grant making.

How will we do this?

Grow our Funding

We want to do more good in our community, so we're focusing on getting more money to give out as grants. Our goal is to give out £2 million in grants annually over the next five years. That means we can support even more projects that make a real difference in people's lives.

Measure our Impact Better

We really care about making a positive difference, which is why we're going to start using an updated salesforce system to measure how effective our grants are. This will help us see exactly how much of an impact we're making in the communities we serve, so we can do even better in the future.

Work Towards Big Goals

We know that big problems need big solutions. That's why we're going to talk more about how our grants are helping to achieve important global goals, like those set by the United Nations. By doing this, we can make sure our efforts are making a real difference locally and globally.

Stay Flexible

Communities change, and we want to make sure our grants can adapt to those changes. We'll keep an eye on what's happening in our community by listening to local experts and keeping track of what people need. This way, we can make sure our grants are always going where they're needed most.

Include Everyone

We believe that everyone should have a fair chance to benefit from our grants. That's why we're going to make sure our grants reach every part of Northamptonshire, no matter who you are or where you live. By including everyone, we can make sure our grants are making a real difference for everyone in our community.

GOAL THREE: ENRICH AND DEEPEN CONNECTIONS

It is through building meaningful relationships that we really get to know and understand the motivations and wishes of our donors, the work and passion of voluntary community groups and charities and the needs of local communities. Northamptonshire Community Foundation as a place-based funder is an essential part of the local voluntary sector ecosystem and has an important responsibility to ensure effective reach across Northamptonshire not just in terms of profile but in relation to connections to local communities across the county and build on existing connections.

We will work alongside donors, voluntary community sector and charities and wider stakeholders to meet the challenges across our local communities and work towards local solutions to transform and change people's lives. As part of this commitment, we will continue to bring philanthropists, community groups and charities together through a series of community conversations to work towards creating a sustainable and thriving Northamptonshire.

We will stay connected with our foundation family and new friends through effective communications, online and face to face providing updated news on grant making and philanthropy activity, local intelligence and opportunities to connect through events and conversations.

We will commit to providing the best donor care and grant services support to ensure we build valued, honest and supportive relationships listening and responding to their needs and improving our services to reflect those needs.

Equity, diversity, and inclusion are principles that we will embrace fully to ensure that we make connections with all communities across Northamptonshire and to really connect and understand the challenges facing everyone.

How will we do this?

We will listen to their needs and challenges and be a fair, honest, transparent, and effective funder. We will help them in ways to connect and network as well as the distribution of grants.

We will use our communications and networks to raise the profile and promote the great work happening in our communities and the unsung heroes that are changing people's lives for the better. We will champion the cause for ongoing funding for small community groups and charities because of the big impact they have to help change the world locally on our doorstep.

How will we do this?

Active Advocacy

As a grant maker, we will advocate on behalf of small under the radar community groups and charities, ensuring their voices are heard and their needs are considered in decision-making processes. We will use our platform and influence to raise awareness about the importance of supporting these organizations and the impact they have on local communities.

Responsive Funding

Tailor grant-making processes to be fair, transparent, and responsive to the needs and challenges faced by small community groups and charities. Provide flexible funding options that meet their unique requirements, whether it's for programme support, capacity building, or operational expenses.

Capacity Building

Offer support beyond financial assistance by providing capacity-building resources and training opportunities to help strengthen the organisational capacity of small community groups and charities. This may include workshops on fundraising, governance, strategic planning, and impact measurement.

Networking and Collaboration

Facilitate networking opportunities and encourage collaboration among small community groups and charities to leverage resources, share best practices, and amplify their impact. We will help raise the aspirations of all our donor's giving and the impact of the funded activities being carried out by aligning their wishes and the good work being delivered by funded community groups and charities to the UN SDGs. We will use the UN SDGs to talk about the work of Northamptonshire Community Foundation and involve everyone on the journey to helping meet the global goals for 2030 from staff and trustees to donors, voluntary community groups and charities. We will do this through a series of community conversations so we can all work together to identify the good work happening and what more can be done.

We will look to identify opportunities for all donors and generosity givers to the foundation to build funds and community investments that help meet the global goals and to celebrate the achievements of those funds in helping build a better world.

How will we do this?

Educate on the goals

Empower them to align their efforts with the global goals and understand how their contributions can make a meaningful impact.

Facilitate Collaboration

We will foster collaboration and partnerships among stakeholders, including donors, community groups, charities, and other organizations, to collectively work towards the UN SDGs. Create platforms for networking, knowledge-sharing, and joint initiatives to maximize impact and leverage resources effectively.

Integrate SDGs into grant-making processes
